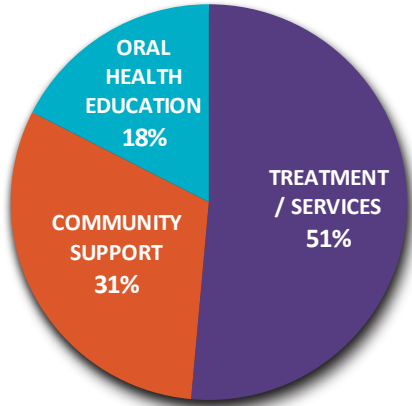

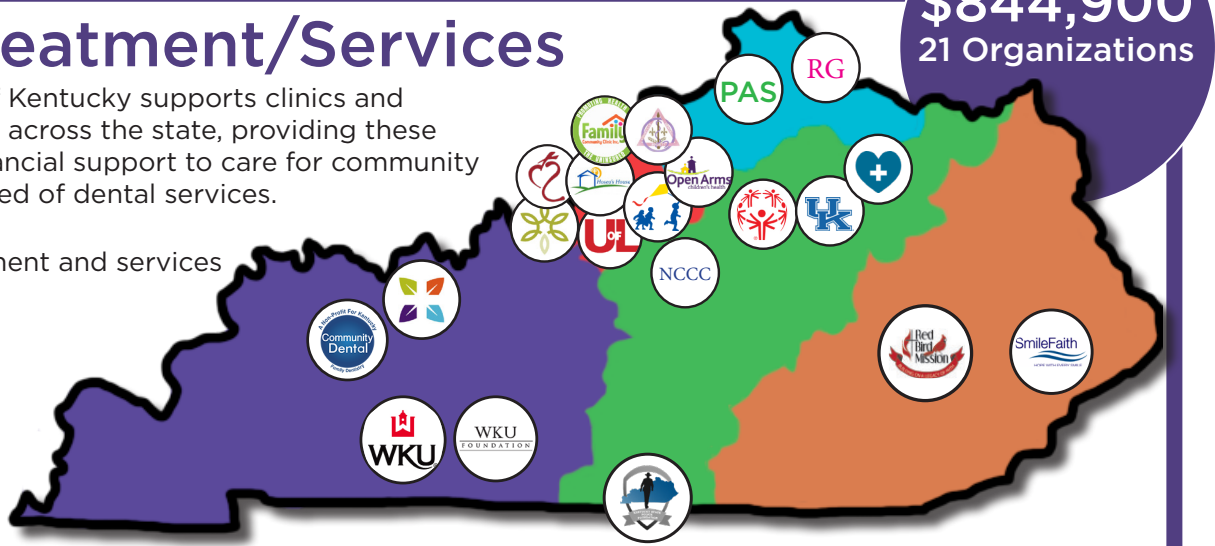

Delta Dental of Kentucky is dedicated to improving oral health education by providing funds to programs that demonstrate the importance of good oral health in daily life.



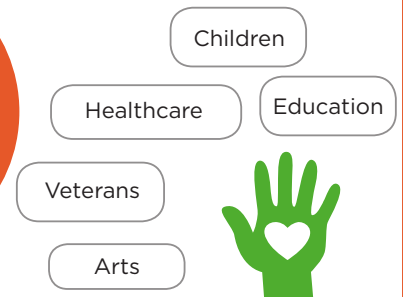

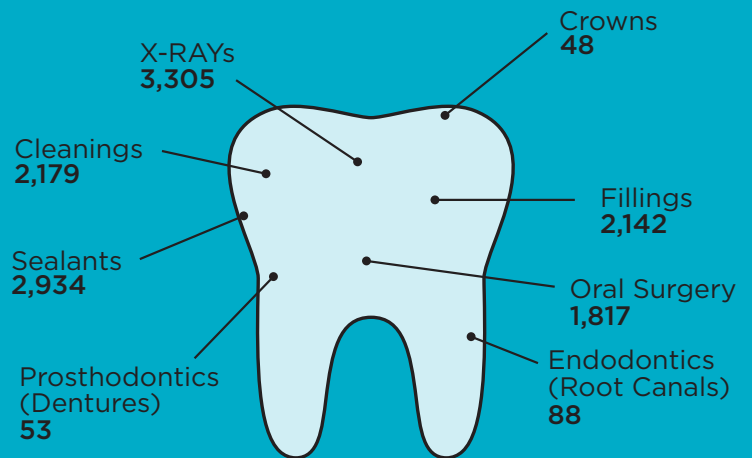
